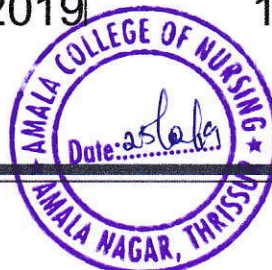

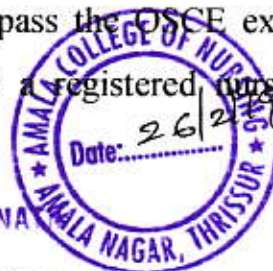
BUILD UP YOUR CAREER- 2019

An orientation program on the recruitment of nurses to UK for BSc nursing final year students was conducted on 26 Feb 2019, by Mr. Joykutty and Mr. Amal from ISDC organized by Amala college of nursing in collaboration with ISDC. The program co-coordinator of ISDC explained the process of migration of nurses to the UK. The migration process includes requirements of Qualified certificates for nurses, IELTS 7,0 band /OET test passed, CBT test passed, and OSCE should be passed after reaching the UK. There is an increased chance for nurses in the UK as there is an increased job vacancy for nurses, around 45,000. The fresher who passed out recently can also apply for UK migration. In the first step, the students who are interested to apply are given an orientation program by ISDC professionals. Next, the students with their parents are given counseling. In this step they give the complete process details regarding the training and they can ensure their transparency.

The entire program is 3 months. After completing the BSc nursing course the interested students can approach the ISDC center. They conduct an interview and select the eligible and interested students and they give training for IELTS, OET, CBT and OSCE for 3 months. The programme cost nearly 1.5 lakh and they have guaranteed to refund the entire amount after the students successfully completed the course and work as a registered nurse in the UK

After passing CBT, IELTS / OET are provided with opportunity to have interviews with 5 hospitals. Then the students can select the most appropriate hospital. They will arrange the VISA and flight ticket after passing all the exams. After reaching there, students have to pass the OSCE exam within 3 months. Students are given 3 chances to pass the OSCE exam after passing OSCE examination students can work as a registered nurse and enjoy the international living standards.

Amala Nursing College, an institution affiliated to **Kerala University of Health Science - Thrissur** approved by the (State Nursing Council) and Indian Nursing Council; conducting Graduate and Post Graduate Courses in Nursing having its premises and office at Amalanagar, Thrissur, Kerala 680555. (**Amala Nursing College**), hereinafter referred to as the **SECOND PARTY**.

WHEREAS

- a. The First Party, - ISDC, a Skill Development Company having expertise in Professional and Vocational Education and is interested in associating with the Second Party to promote and deliver the Graduate Certificate in Health Care Practices validated by the University of the West of Scotland, UK to the Final Year BSc /MSc Nursing Students or Alumni's of the **Amala Nursing College**.
- b. The Second Party on its part is interested in associating with First Party for promoting the Graduate Certificate in Health Care Practices as a potential career enhancement tool to its Final Year BSc/MSc Nursing Graduates and Alumni's.
- c. Graduate Certificate in Health Care Practices is a test preparatory program for Career Enhancement developed by ISDC in conjunction with the University of the West of Scotland (UWS) and the same has been validated by UWS; leads to UWS Awards to the students on Successful completion of the Program. Graduate Certificate in Health Care Practices is embedded and integrated with the OET (Occupational English Test), CBT

(Computer Based Training for Health Care & Nursing Professionals) test curriculum; which helps Nurses to register with Nursing and Midwifery Council, UK on successful completion of the OET & CBT - for a potential employment in United Kingdom at National Health Service (NHS) Trust Hospitals.

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to set forth the terms and conditions under which the Parties to this understanding shall conduct themselves during the subsistence of the Memorandum.

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is not, and is not intended to be, legally binding except as specifically set out below.

1. The Second Party shall support the First Party to promote the Graduate Certificate in Health Care Practices to its Final Year BSc/MSc Nursing Graduates and Alumni's.
2. The First Party takes care of the complete delivery of the Graduate Certificate in Health Care Practices at its Training Centres or at the Premises of the Second Party based on the mutual arrangements time to time.
3. The First party can use the name of the "Amala Nursing College" for promoting the Graduate Certificate in Health Care Practices in advertisements and other modes of communications.
4. The admission criteria and the number of seats for the above said program is fixed by the First Party.
5. The First Party facilitate the necessary exam-oriented training support as a part of the program to the students enrolled for the Graduate Certificate in Health Care Practices; this enables the students to attend the OET and CBT Examinations to pursue the NMC Registration.
6. The Students have to follow the rules and regulations of ISDC and University of the West of Scotland to successfully complete the Graduate Certificate in Health Care Practices.

15. Where the Collaboration reasonably requires the use by one party of intellectual property that is owned by the other party (the "IPR Owner"), the IPR Owner will licence such rights to the other party on a non-exclusive basis, without the right to sub-licence, solely for the purpose and to the extent necessary in connection with the Collaboration. Any such licence will automatically terminate when the MoU is terminated.

16. For the purposes of this MoU, "**Confidential Information**" shall be all information of a confidential nature (whether written or oral) concerning the business and affairs of either party which is obtained or received as a result of the discussions leading up to, the entering into or the performance of this MoU, including financial information, training & learning material, trade secrets, College lists, trade and commercial details and computer software and databases, the contents of all reports and documentation prepared by either party or on its behalf and any other information of a confidential nature designated by a party as confidential;

Each of the parties shall at all times while this MoU remains in force and after it has terminated, keep confidential the Confidential Information except where:

- The Confidential Information was already lawfully known, or became lawfully known to either of the parties independently;
- Disclosure or use is necessary by either of the parties (including their employees, agents and sub-contractors) for the proper and effective performance of this MoU;
- Disclosure is required by law to any government, governmental department, agency, regulatory or fiscal body or authority (whether national or foreign) and their authorized agents (including professional advisers);
- The Confidential Information is disclosed, in the case of ISDC, to another member of the ISDC group of companies;
- Each party undertakes to the other that it will not disclose or make use of, for its own benefit, any of the Confidential Information of that other party.

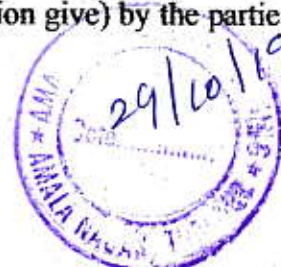

7. The First Party provides the necessary placement support to the successful students who have completed the Graduate Certificate in Health Care Practices and cleared OET & CBT Tests as per the NMC norms.
8. The First Party works with its group companies or partner companies in India and UK to execute the contract.
9. The Process Flow and Cycle is detailed in **Annexure 1** of this MU for easy understanding.
10. The financial arrangement, fee structure and eligible refunds to the students are detailed in the **Annexure 2** of this MOU.
11. **The First Party pay INR 10000/- to the Second Party for each student enrolled from them.**
12. It is intended that the terms of this MoU will remain in force for an initial period of Three Years set out above or is otherwise terminated in accordance with the provisions of Clause 13. The MoU can be extended for further periods after the expiry of Three Years upon the parties mutually agreeing such extension in writing. The terms of this Memorandum may be modified at any time by both parties on mutual consent.
13. Either party shall be entitled to terminate the MOU on 60 days' notice. The MoU will automatically terminate:
 - If either party becomes insolvent;
 - Any potential Binding Agreement would be unenforceable, void or illegal due to any **statutory or regulatory requirements; or**
 - Terminates any Binding Agreement for cause.
 - In the event of the termination of the agreement, the First Party agrees to complete the existing batches on agreed terms.
14. All intellectual property created by a party in connection with the Collaboration shall remain the property of that party. The parties agree that any material jointly created by the parties for the Collaboration shall be jointly owned (in proportions to the contribution given) by the parties, unless otherwise agreed in writing.

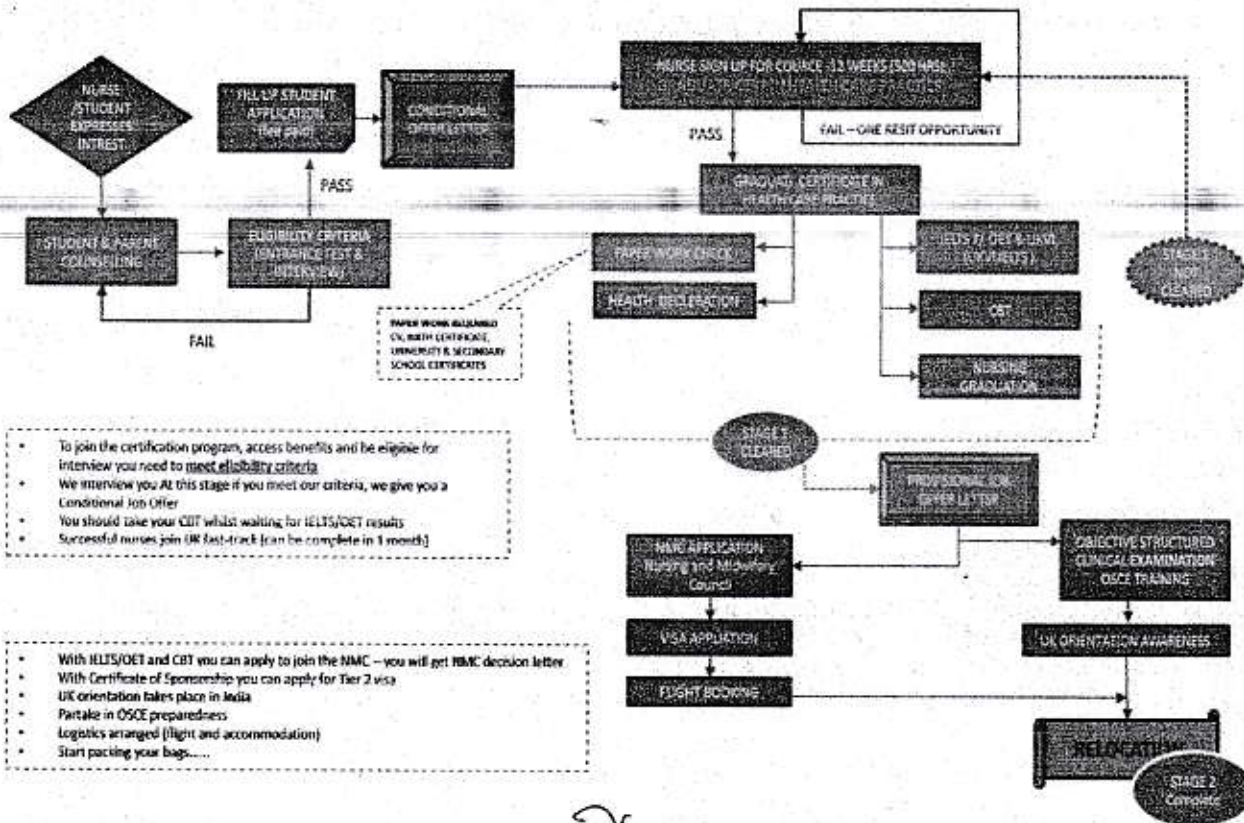

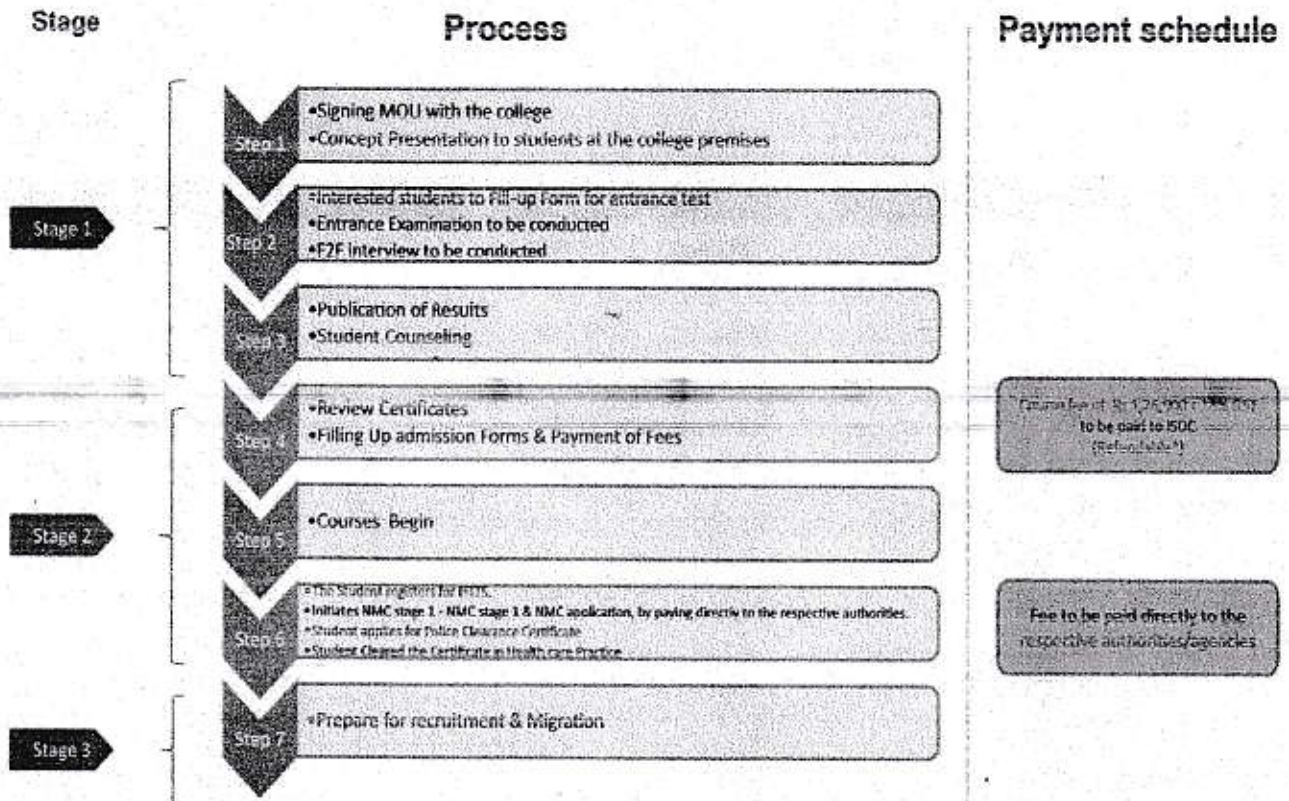
The Process Flow and Cycle
