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PROJECT ON QUALITY INDICATORS – INITIAL ASSESSMENT

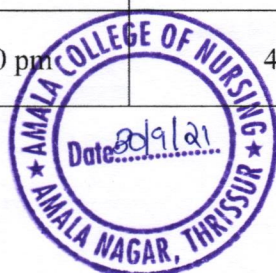
Quality is defined as the extended resemblance between the purpose of health care and the truly granted care. (Donabedian)

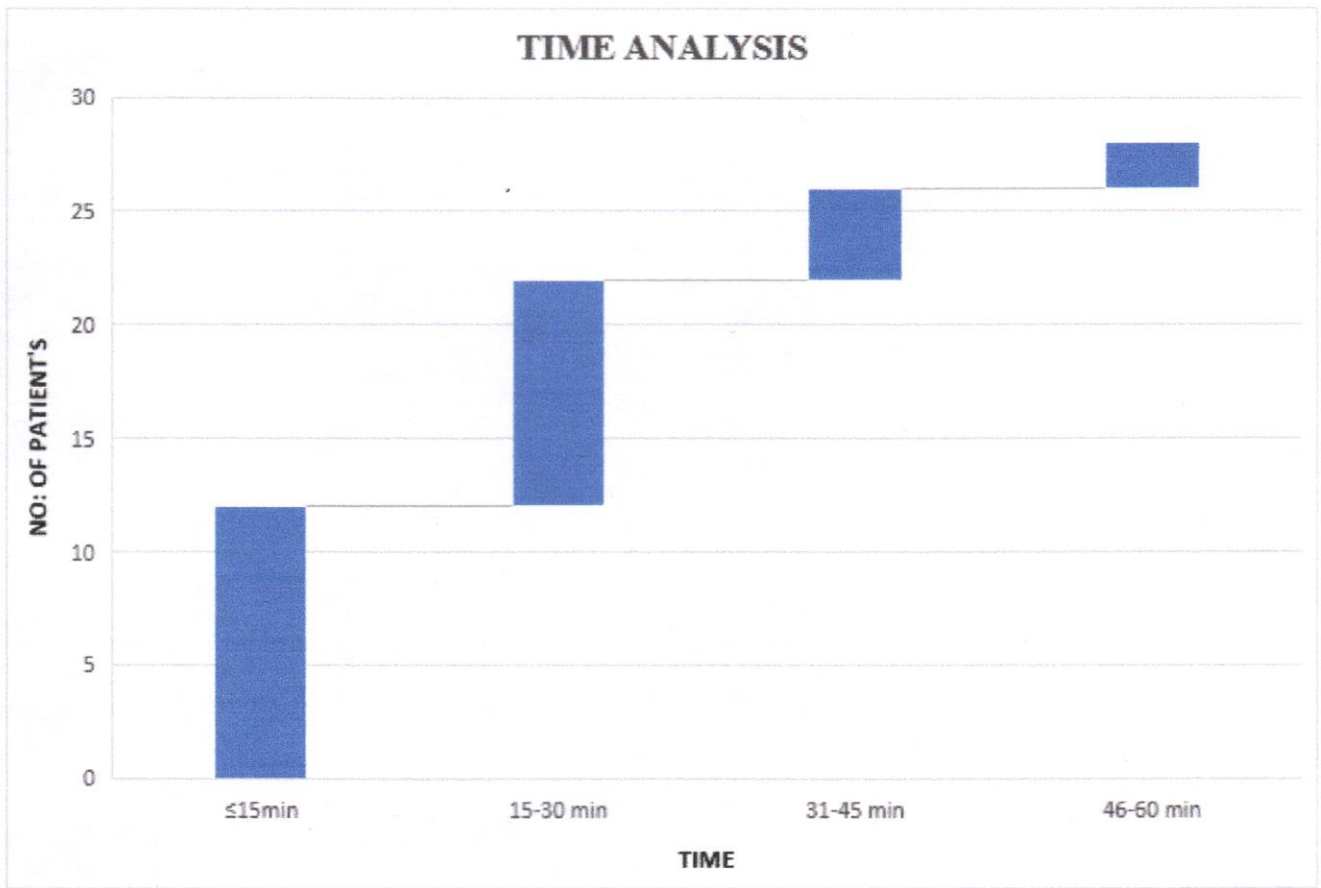

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The above graph shows that the majority of the initial assessment of patients was done within 15min, and out of 28 samples, only 2 initial assessments were completed by 46-60mins.

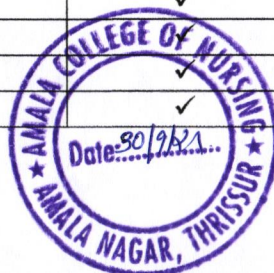
