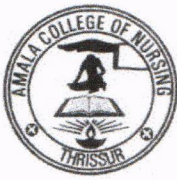

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REPORT OF CLINICAL PRECEPTORSHIP PROGRAM

(ROMIA-Role Modelling Initiative @ ACON)

Preceptorship is a time-limited, education-focused model for teaching and learning within a clinical environment that uses clinical staff as role models. Its primary goal is to assist new staff and students to adapt to their roles, develop clinical skills and socialize the novice to a department or institution.

- Henderson et al. describe a preceptor as a skilled clinician, a registered nurse (RN), who can provide students with the guidance and experience to facilitate their learning.
- Using this model, students work under the supervision of the registered nurse, who provides individualized support, to facilitate the achievement of clinical learning outcomes.
- The preceptorship model has been reported to play an important role in professional socialization for nursing students

Why preceptorship

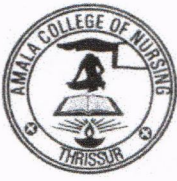
- ▶ Preceptorship is a strategy commonly used in nursing education.
- ▶ Its benefits have been reported in assisting nursing students and novice nurses with reality based knowledge
- ▶ Skill acquisition

Clinical preceptorship in Amala

- ▶ The idea of preceptorship stemmed from the gaps experienced in the clinical setting as expressed by students in the first meeting of HMCC in December 2019
- ▶ The students expressed their difficulties in gaining complete clinical experiences as they were also made to run around for errand in the ward
- ▶ This stimulated the thought for more involvement by the clinical staff in student supervision which will provide the dual advantages of students benefits and additional manpower to the ward

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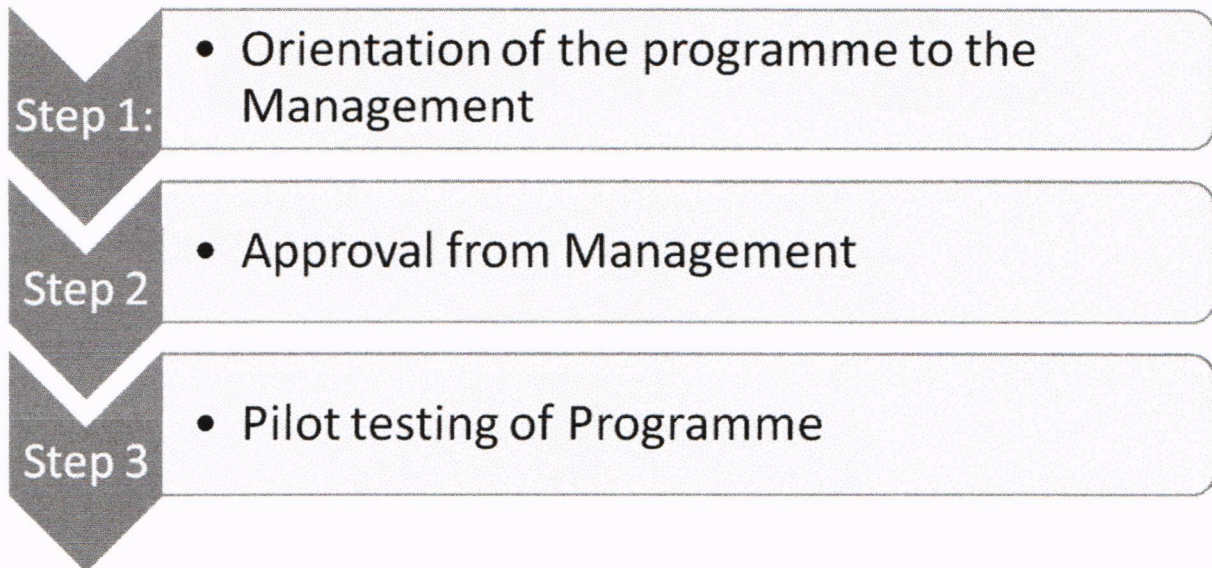


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STAGES OF IMPLEMENTATION IN AMALA
