#### **INTRODUCTION**

Nurse clinics offer an alternative model of care delivery where the nurse is the primary provider of care for the patient. The nursing services provided are holistic and patient-centred, with accountability and responsibility for patient care and professional practice remaining with the nurse. In Amala a nurse led clinic will be a collaborative clinic in collaboration with the concerned medical departments. If implemented we will be the first college of nursing in Kerala to carry out nurse led geriatric clinics (Collaborative geriatric clinic).

#### **PUPROSES**

- Patients need to play an active, ongoing role in their health care and treatment (e.g. diabetes)
- Greater patient education and understanding is needed (e.g. post operative states, oncology
- A closer, longer-term relationship between patients and caregivers is needed (e.g. diabetes, geriatrics, dialysis)
- Establishing trust is important (e.g, mental health)

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#### **HOW IT WORKS**

Identification and assessment of risk group from wards by faculty Home care instructions and educative and rehabilitative services on fixed days of week (as per their revisit schedule)

Follow up and support services

New areas

Geriatric wellness clinic ( along with course on geriatric care)

Post stroke rehabilitation clinic (along with holistic approach)

NCD and life style clinic

Post mastectomy &lymphedema clinic

#### PILOT TESTING OF THE PROJECT

The discussion with Dr revealed that there needs to be a geriatric team formed in collaboration with ACON and AMC and together the team will start function in an experimental way to


- Create awareness of geriatrics among the medical and nursing fraternity in the clinical area.
- To take assessment of all patients admitted in the hospital above 60 years of age.
- To create a pool of geriatric patients and follow up them continuously.
- Initially using virtual platforms ./ regular phone calls.

#### **REQUIREMENTS FOR PILOT TESTING**

- Approval and permissions from management and HODs
- Provisions to create and deliver IEC material
- Preparation of assessment proformas
- Team creation (geriatrician, geriatric nurse specialist (CON faculty), social worker, dietitian, physiotherapist, spiritual counselor)
- Selection of areas for pilot testing (wards, Icus) 2 wards and 2 Icu
- Dedicated phone no for follow-up activities

#### Advantages of collaborative geriatric clinic

- Long term plan- to convert the hospital to an geriatric friendly hospital
- Able to comprehensively assess the geriatric patients admitted in the ward
- Suggest geriatric based care modifications for patients and prevent complications in them
- Provide care giver support and education
- Through clinic regular followup of all patients above 60 years and admitted in Amala
- To provide psychological spiritual nutritional and other support activities through clinic
- Will be the first hospital in south India to implement geriatric collaborative clinic
