
Two additional items were evaluated such as online classes and care during covid 19 and parents expressed average to good opinion regarding both.










Parent feedback analysis second year


The second year parents expressed general satisfaction regarding the overall performance of the college and the facilities the online classes were evaluated by them also.




Parent feedback third year
