REPORT OF CURRICULUM FEEDBACK FROM STUDENTS IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2017-2018

The annual feedback on curriculum for the academic year 2017-2018 was obtained in the month of August 2017. Base on the analysis of feedback forms; the conclusions were:

a) Curriculum feedback by students

- 1. Majority of the students (54%) rated curriculum and syllabus of the course as Excellent.
- Most of the students rated Excellent/Good coverage of syllabus in class (45% and 48% respectively) while 7% pointed Average coverage.
- Majority of the students rated Excellent course delivery by faculty members while 5% rated Average.
- Teaching learning process was rated Excellent by 54% of students, Good by 39% and Average by 7%.
- Majority of the students rated fairness in evaluation process as Excellent, 38% as Good while 6% as Average.

b) Curriculum feedback - Teachers

- 1. Majority of the faculty rated the syllabus as suitable to subject (87%), need based (73%), aims and objectives well defined (73%).
- 2. 20% pointed that the syllabus needs more time to be covered.
- 3. Majority were satisfied with the reference materials available (87%)



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c) <u>Curriculum feedback – Other professionals</u>

- Majority of the other professionals rated involvement in patient care (91%), communication and interpersonal skills (73%), knowledge on subject matter (91%) as Very good.
- The professional attributes like assertiveness and mutual respect of nursing students was rated as Very good by 100%
- 3. Majority rated Very good for accountability (92%), punctuality (91%), approachability (91%) respectively.
- 4. However only 73% rated Very good for leadership and critical thinking abilities.

d) Curriculum feedback – Alumni

- 1. 95% of the alumni were satisfied with the theory learning experience, clinical skills learned, clinical exposure and clinical guidance by faculty and hospital staff.
- 2. All of them always felt that the periodic evaluation conducted were effective in enhancing learning.

e) <u>Curriculum feedback – Employers</u>

The overall job performance of alumni as staff nurses were expressed as satisfactory. A suggestion to include more training in basic clinical skills was made by the Chief Nursing Officer of Amala Institute of Medical Sciences.



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ACTION TAKEN REPORT

An evaluation of curriculum feedback was done in curriculum committee meeting headed by the principal. The action suggested for enhancement was:

- a) Extend of syllabus coverage to be over looked by subject coordinators.
- b) Printed notes, remedial classes for weak students.
- c) Including more reference books.
- d) Focus on basic clinical skill attainment of students.
