

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a) GENERAL OVERVIEW OF THE COMMITTEE

Chairperson gave a brief introduction about the overall function of the curriculum committee and roles and responsibilities of the members. Discussion was made on the frequency of committee meeting. It was decided that the committee shall meet every three monthly or whenever required.

b) POLICY ON EXAMINATION AND FEEDBACK

Guidelines regarding the examination pattern of the institution like sessional exams, unit test, question paper setting and feedback procedures were discussed. It was decided that three sessional exams should include 30%, 40% and 30% of the total syllabus. Three sets of question papers are to be set and submitted to the examination cell. Evaluation of examination should be done within 7 days. Unit test should be conducted on completion of each unit. Innovative teaching methods like augmented learning, self directed learning, peer learning, simulation etc should be promoted. Routine feedback to be obtained from students and teacher regarding curriculum.

a) EVALUATION OF CURRICULUM FEEDBACK

An evaluation on curriculum feedback obtained for the year of 2018-19 was done. The major issues identified on the evaluation were

- * Lack of clarity in aims and objectives of course
- * Lack of adequate reference materials
- * Lack of balance between theory and application
- * Lack of clarity between hours and mark distribution
- Lack of adequate practical sessions

b) PLAN REMEDIAL ACTIONS

A discussion was made on measures to overcome the issues identified on evaluation of curriculum feedback. The remedial actions planned include

* Syllabus orientation to be given at the beginning of academic year by course coordinators and supervised by class coordinators.

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* Allot more library hours and ensure utilization of reference materials and journals available

* Provide lecture notes and simplified notes by subject teachers

* Subject teachers to ensure integration of theory and practical components

 Check feasibility for including more practical sessions in subjects like nursing management and education

* Instruction to all teachers to include more innovative teaching strategies to generate interest in subject area

* Allotment of adequate time to ensure effective coverage of syllabus

* Integration of the add on programs to ensure enrichment of curriculum and include possibility for research and employability
