COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Being entrusted by parents to provide care for their newly born baby is both a

privilege and an extra ordinary responsibility. The neonatal resuscitation

programme is an educational programme designed to introduce the concepts and

skills needed to resuscitate a new born child.

This programme is designed to provide a comprehensive training for nursing

students to enable them to effectively manage a neonatal emergency. The NRP

course is delivered using experienced practitioners who deal with neonatal

emergencies on a regular basis. The course will be presented using case studies,

skill stations, simulations and other interactive delivery methodologies. Learning

strategies have been selected to help participant learn both cognitive and

psychomotor skills.

The aim of NRP is to prepare nursing students with skills and knowledge required to effectively manage and care for a new born in distress.
