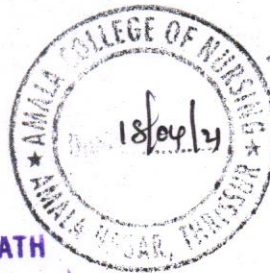

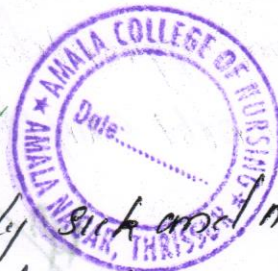

Community health Nurses Replies : we are nurses who takes care of people who are critically ill, and we are coming from nearby community health centre.

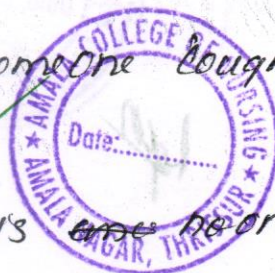
Question :- Is anyone here who is very much ill and need <sup>for</sup> help

Our family was a happy family, when we were 4 members in the family, Me, husband and 2 sons.

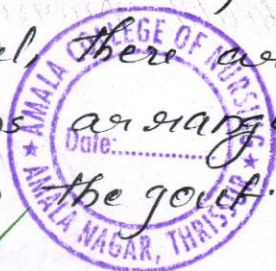
All the events held in our home, we tried to make it interesting. we never felt our son in a leave our sons in their difficult crises, we always supported them throughout their lifetime and till their marriage.

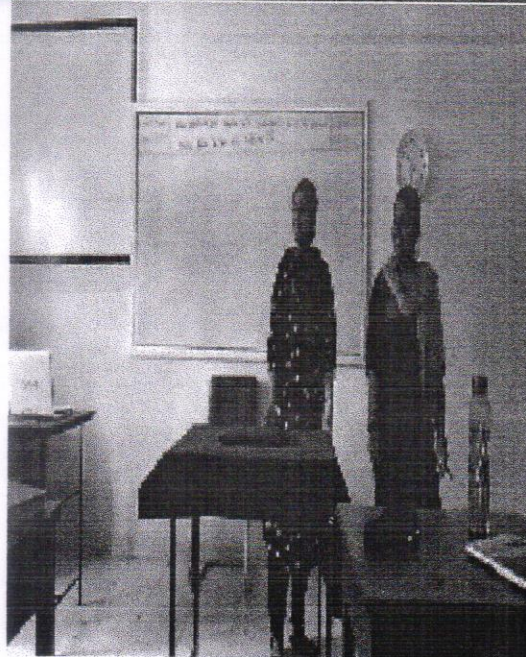
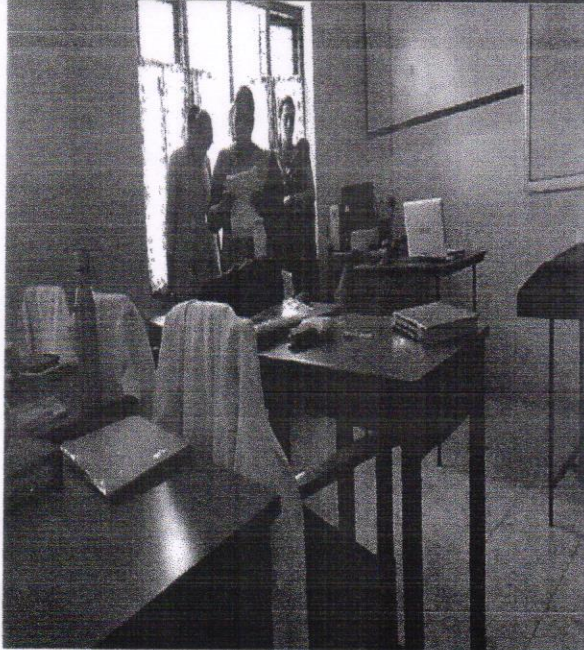
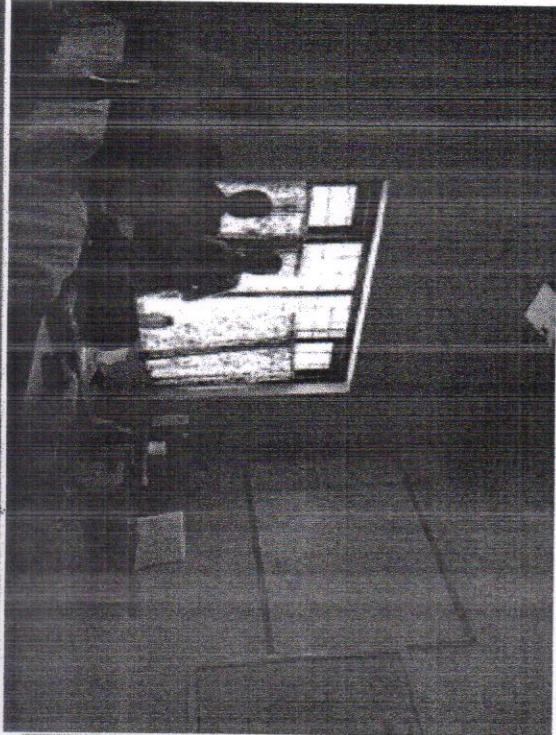
