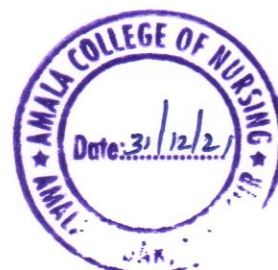

Speak to Mr. Varghese about lithium; provide psycho education and counselling to the patient and family about Lithium therapy.



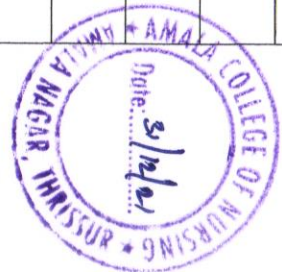

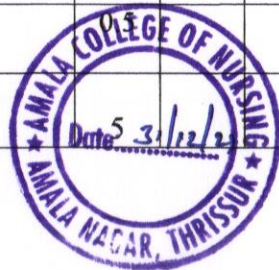
