RESEARCH – CODE OF ETHICS FOR INSTITUTION

All the research involving human participants should be conducted in avoidance with the four basic ethical principles namely autonomy, beneficience, non-maleficience and justice.

In research on sensitive issues, this will have to be properly addressed in the research protocol to safeguard the human rights of dependent persons and population.

Code of ethics for an institution is set to guide the professional and personal conduct of members of the institution in relation to various human research activities.

- 1. The research activities are necessary for the advancement of knowledge and practice for the benefit of all members of the human species.
- 2. Ethical committee shall decide on the consent to be taken or its agreement based on the degree of risk that may be involved
- 3. Non exploitation of research participants irrespective of their social and economic condition or education levels
- 4. Identity and records of the human participants involved in the research are kept confidential
- 5. Due attention is taken at all stages of the research activities to ensure that the research participants are put to the minimum risk.
- 6. Research is conducted by competent and qualified persons who act with total integrity and impartiality.
- 7. Research will be conducted in a equitable honest, unbiased and transparent manner.
- 8. All institutional arrangements required to be made in respect of the research and its application are duly made in a bonafide and crystal clear manner. All appropriate steps should be taken to ensure that research reports, materials and data connected with the research are duly preserved and archived.
- 9. Research must be brought to the public domain so that its results are generally made known through scientific and other publications.
- 10. The effect of the research is duly monitored and constantly subjected to review and remedial action at all stages of the research for its future use.

Institutions believe that, to monitor all these principles of ethics in research done by teachers and students of this college, an institutional ethical committee is needed. All research done in this institution should be screened by IEC which is formulated and registered according to the guidelines of ICMR.
