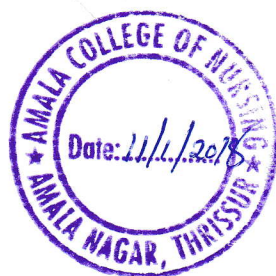
Amala College of Nursing was recognized as a centre to conduct Ph.D. programme in Nursing by KUHS in the year 2017. Other important events in the year 2017 are:

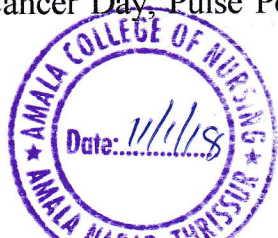

Students received an approximate amount of Rs.49,56,042/- (Rupees forty nine lakh fifty six thousand and forty two only) as scholarship in the year 2017.

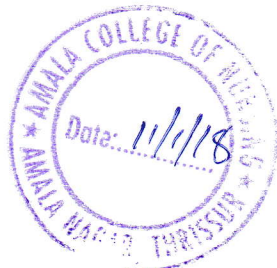
8. Other events
