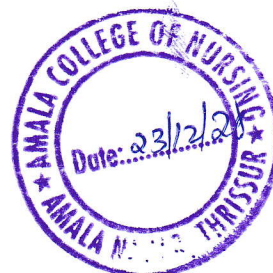
15th ANNUAL REPORT 2019-2020
